WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR II

Job Summary: Under general supervision, maintains the City's potable water treatment plant, industrial water plant, booster stations and reservoirs. Performs maintenance and operation activities at the potable water treatment plant, industrial water source and booster stations. Duties also include the inspection, operation and maintenance of Water Utility equipment. Work will involve shifts that include weekends and holidays or non-standard hours.

Salary: \$28,384 - \$33,901 per hour (\$59,038.72-\$70,514.08 annually)
Full-time position. Excellent benefits include medical, dental and vision coverage for employee and dependents, life insurance, long-term disability insurance, vacation/sick leave accrual, PERS retirement and deferred compensation plans. Employee shares 12.5% of the medical premium. Position is represented by AFSCME Local #1619.

Qualifications:

Education and Certifications:

Must have or obtain a valid First Aid card.
Must have or be able to acquire within 30 days a valid State of Washington driver's license and a driving record acceptable to the City's Risk Manager.
Must have basic familiarity with personal computer and associated software.
Possession of a valid State of Washington Water Treatment Plant Operator II certification or the ability to acquire a WTP Operator II certification within six months of hire.

Experience:

Three years of work experience as a Water Treatment Plant Operator I and a Water Treatment Plant Operator II certification or the ability to acquire a Water Treatment Plant Operator II certification within 6 months of hire.

A Water Distribution Manager II and Cross Connection Control Specialist certification is desirable.

Coursework available through California State University (Ken Kerri correspondence course), Green River Community College online coursework, or other equivalent programs.
